Get a jump on spoiling Mom at Staller Estate Winery, Delavan, on Saturday, May 6, from 12 - 3 pm, as they offer a Mother's Day Inspired Wine & Dine. Enjoy local foods prepared by Tyler from Black Sheep of Whitewater, excellently paired with Staller Estate wine. What better way to treat Mom to a meal away from the kitchen!

Also ahead of Mother's Day, the Cornerstone Shop & Gallery, Lake Geneva, on Saturday, May 12, from 12 - 3 pm, is hosting a Mother's Day Tea Tasting Party. In addition to education and sampling of teas for spring, there is also a Lizzy James Trunk Show to enjoy.

Begin Mother's Day itself, Sunday, May 13, with a Bird Hike at Beulah Bog State Natural Area, East Troy, from 8:30 - 9:30 am. A beautiful beginning to the morning with bird songs and sightings, hosted by the Kettle Moraine Land Trust and led by the Friends of the Mukwonago River.

Celebrate the 'Remarkable Women of Geneva Lake' while taking a voyage with the Lake Geneva Cruise Line to Black Point Estate & Gardens, Lake Geneva, an 1888 Queen Anne Victorian "lake summer cottage". Leaving promptly at 12:30 pm, this narrated boat tour will focus on many of the remarkable women that have lived along the shore of Geneva Lake. The cruise then includes a tour of Black Point Estate, with mimosas being served on the veranda before returning to the boat.

Another look back in time is available at Old World Wisconsin, Eagle, as they host a scrumptious breakfast buffet in the historic 1894 Clausing Barn. There are multiple seating times from 9:30 am to 1:15 pm and advance registration is required. After the meal, head outside to enjoy the views of Old World Wisconsin's springtime landscape, with all Moms getting in free to the site.

If Mom likes some entertainment with her meal, then head to Rosewood, Delavan, for fresh, farm-to-table cuisine and a musical cabaret performance of their “Legends & Love Songs” show, with reserved seating at 11:30 am and 1 pm, with the show at 2 pm. The “Legends & Love Songs” features music by Elvis, Aretha Franklin, and Frank Sinatra, to name just a few, and is a show of unforgettable voices in popular music that is both timeless and ageless.

Another entertainment and meal option is the Fireside Dinner Theatre, Fort Atkinson, where the current show is ‘42nd Street’, a celebration of Broadway, Times Square and those that make the magic of musical theatre. Brunch and the show is offered, 10:30 am - 2:30 pm, and then dinner and the show is offered 2:30 - 6:30 pm.

There are several other Mother’s Day brunches and meal options in the area to choose from: Evergreen Country Club, Elkhorn, 9 am - 2 pm; The Ridge, Lake Geneva, 9 am - 2 pm, The Abbey Resort, Fontana, 9 am - 5 pm; Lake Lawn Resort, Delavan, 9:30 am - 4 pm; Grand Geneva Resort, Lake Geneva, 10 am - 3 pm; The Red Geranium, Lake Geneva, 10 am - 4 pm; and The Hunt Club Steakhouse, Lake Geneva, 2 - 9 pm.
